- Farm name may be used if the stable or farm is the bona fide owner appearing on the horse's registration papers. The owner must have an AHA Business membership, and that owner AHA number must be used. The owner must have a USEF Farm ID# or Farm Recording Certificate and one of the owner's must be a qualified USEF member. Copies of AHA Business membership card USEF Farm ID# or Certificate must be submitted with the entry.
- Horses entered in AMATEUR OWNER and JUNIOR OWNER classes must be registered in the name of competitor or member of competitor's family.
- Every Owner Exhibitor Trainer & Rider/Driver/Handler or his/her agent(s) must sign the back of the entry blank. In the case of a Rider/Driver/Handler under 18 his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer must sign the entry blank on minor's behalf. Junior Owners are not eligible to sign as trainer — adult must sign as trainer. If no trainer, owner must sign as owner & trainer. Include copies of current USEF Membership cards for EVERY Owner Trainer Rider Handler Driver and Junior Owner & Rider.
- Include copies of current AHA COMPETITION membership cards for Owner/Trainer/Rider/Handler Driver/Junior Owner & Riders AND at least one current owner. If any of the above persons do not have a current AHA Competition Card, each must pay **\$35.00 ONCE ONLY FOR BOTH SHOWS**. (i.e. if entered in a double judged class and you do not have an AHA Competition Card you will be required to pay **\$35 ONE TIME ONLY**)
- Walk Trot riders must list their birthdates on the back of the entry form under the parent signature. If address of Walk/Trot rider is different than owner listed on entry form, please write the W/T rider address on the back of the entry.

STABLING INFORMATION

Each animal must be assigned to a separate stall (exception: broodmares with suckling foals) unless no stall is requested, in which case a trailer-in fee shall be charged. Stalls will be available on April 15, 2024 after 12pm, stalls must be vacated by April 21, 2024 before 8pm. Exhibitors arriving prior, or departing later than these specified dates, should contact the Barn Manager to make special arrangements and will be required to pay an additional daily fee per stall. Stall Management reserves the right to refuse a stall or tack room to any exhibitors. People requesting special stall arrangements for handicapped or disabled must have the Blue State Handicap Card. Card number must be listed with stall request.

SHOW INFORMATION

ASSIGNMENT OF STALLS

EXHIBITORS WISHING TO BE STABLED TOGETHER MUST SUBMIT THEIR ENTRIES IN THE SAME ENVELOPE.

Assignment of stalls will be made as fairly as possible on the basis of many considerations: Patron/sponsorship participation, time of entry, number of horses, number of class entries, past participation in the show and show décor, club membership & overall pattern for optimum barn use are the major considerations for stabling assignments. We ask your cooperation in these assignments. If you have special requests or considerations please submit them with your entry. All requests will be considered but no promises can be made. **Be advised: stall requests for horses entered after "close of entries" or post entered late and request stabling with other horses previously entered original stall assignments will not be changed to accommodate the late entry.** Management will try to stable late entries AS CLOSE AS POSSIBLE to other entries but NO GUARANTEES. Show management's decision is final.

PATRON STALL INFORMATION – Stalls are reserved for PATRON exhibitors/sponsors on a FIRST COME basis. Patrons will be given first choice on location of barn assignments and will be given priority in the assignment of stall fronts. If more requests for patron stalls are received than available overflow entries will be assigned to portable stalls.

TYPES OF STALLS AVAILABLE

MD BARNs – MD stalls are permanent metal stalls with bars on upper front and upper top of stall doors. They are located adjacent to the warm up arenas.

PORTABLE STALLS will be used for overflow if necessary. These are canvas stalls with bars on upper front and top of stall door.

ALL STALLS/TACK ROOMS ARE SANITIZED AND THEN SEALED, IF A SEAL IS BROKEN, YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PRICE OF THAT STALL OR TACK ROOM IF IN YOUR STABLING ASSIGNMENT. UNASSIGNED STALLS WILL BE EVALUATED FOR PAYMENT RESPONSIBILITY.

STALL DECORATIONS

Stall decorations shall be made of non-flammable or treated material and maintained in flame retardant condition.

SHOWING FROM TRAILERS

Exhibitors MAY show from their trailers. The trailer-in/grounds fee is **\$30.00 PER HORSE PER DAY**. Every horse entered in these shows MUST pay either a stall fee or trailer-in fee

TRAILER PARKING AREAS

As soon as horses are unloaded vehicles must be moved to designated parking areas. No parking in barn aisles.

FEED & SHAVINGS

HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS AND REGISTRATION

Horse Show will be open Tuesday April 18th from 9am. - 5pm, and thereafter on each day of the show from 1 hour before the first scheduled class of the day. The office will remain open one half hour after the completion of the last class of the show.

ARENA DIMENSIONS & FOOTING – Large covered arena (#1) 125 X 280'; large outdoor arena (#2) 180 X 216'; small covered arena (#4) 100 X 230'; warm up arena (#3) 100 X 233'; warm up arena across from large covered arena is 100 X 247'; warm up arena across from arena #2 is 88 X 185'. All arenas have a mixture of sand and dirt for footing.

BREEDING/IN-HAND CLASSES - Breeding/In-Hand show champions & reserves must be at least two years old and are selected as outlined in USEF GR810.5. Arabian/Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian yearling geldings may compete for Champion Gelding.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRY

To encourage early entries the Management agrees to cancel and refund entry stall and all fees on any horse not fit to show providing written or email notification ahancshowsecretary@gmail.com is given to the Show Secretary on or before entry closing date (March 27).

AMATEUR OWNER FAMILY DEFINITION - An Amateur Owner Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider driver or handler is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family. "Family" includes husband wife parent stepparent child brother stepchild sister half-brother and sister aunt uncle niece nephew grandmother grandfather and in-laws of the same relation as stated. Combined ownership is NOT permitted in Amateur/Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. LEASED horses are NOT eligible. (See USEF GR136)

SHOW INFORMATION

CLASS CALLS

Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of exhibitor to be sure that his horse is at the gate at its prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry class calls; however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed on the basis of PA malfunction alone.

COPIES OF AHA & USEF MEMBERSHIP CARDS Owners, trainers, agents, handlers, riders and drivers must provide a legible photocopy of their current AHA and USEF membership cards at time of entry. Reminder! Failure to include copies of the membership cards with entry will result in a late forms fine.

CRUELTY AND ABUSE - USEF GR839 AR105 AND AHA ARTICLE 304.6 WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AT ALL AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITIONS.

DISCIPLINE - Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner lessee trainer groom rider or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse owner lessee trainer groom or rider from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

DISQUALIFICATION

Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly, or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made, or caused to be made a false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting.

DOGS

The State Humane Officer requires dogs to be confined or on a leash at all times and are not allowed outside the barn area. Dogs are NOT ALLOWED in the grandstand or show office area at any time.

DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS

The State of California and USEF requires that both halter and performance horses entering any show offering prize money will be charged a USEF drug testing fee of \$8.00 and a California drug testing fee of \$14 to help defray the expense of testing. USEF and California rules regarding drugs and medications will be enforced. In addition, an \$8 USEF fee must be charged for each horse entered.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE IN AOTR, AAOTr, JOTR CLASSES

Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitors or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF GR 122. (Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by USEF GR 122.) The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted. Horses must be qualified by an amateur owner.

FARRIER - The farrier will be available on the show grounds during show hours.

GATE RULE - Due to a full schedule of classes the TWO-MINUTE limit after last call for a class will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes at the completion of final horse in the continuous string of horses. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction. "Open" cards may be run for Sport Horse, Trail and Reining classes to assist exhibitors who might have a conflict with classes in another arena. Check with show manager or in the show office for details.

HEADGEAR - All juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling & exercise areas the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEA) in any division or class without penalty from the judge.

HALF ARABIAN/ANGLO ARABIAN COLTS/STALLIONS - Half Arabian and Anglo-Arabian stallions registered with AHA or which have been issued an AHA CPAR (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Register) Permit are permitted to compete in the AHA PERFORMANCE CLASSES for HA/AA and Anglo-Arabian horses. Half Arabian and Anglo-Arabian colts & stallions two years & older may compete in Sport Horse In Hand Classes.

GENERAL INFORMATION

RULES - This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Equestrian Federation (National Equestrian Federation of the United States) Chapter AR - Arabian HA/AA and Anglo-Arabian Division. The official Rule Book of US Equestrian will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT U.S. EQUESTRIAN RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. The Show Committee shall decide questions not covered by USEF Rules and its decisions will be final.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

USEF SAFE SPORT STATEMENT - All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION FOR EC AMATEUR MEMBERS - EC amateur members, competing in amateur classes, must complete and sign a USEF membership application verifying they meet USEF amateur requirements. There is no charge.

AMATEUR/OWNER RULE - PLEASE SEE THE USEF RULE BOOK RULE — AR110.4 FOR COMPLETE INFORMATION.

USEF MEMBERSHIP - Affidavits are no longer accepted for payment of non-member fees. Exhibitors must have a Competing Membership, either Life, Senior Active or Junior Active Member or pay a Show Pass Fee. See next paragraph.

USEF NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION - If membership documentation is not submitted to the competition and the competition cannot verify such information, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form and pay a non-refundable Show Pass fee of \$45.00. (GR1309.2.b) Show passes must be purchased online at USEF.org. a Show Pass is only valid for one competition and non-member participants (riders, drivers, handlers, vaulters, longeurs, owners, lessees, and agents) are limited to obtaining no more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card. Join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National competitions. Exhibitors in walk/trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with a competition card at AHA Regional and National competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5/12).

No substitution of horses will be permitted except as provided in USEF Article 1506.2. Absolutely no requests for refunds for ANY reasons will be considered unless such written request with supporting documentation is in the show secretary's hand PRIOR to the show. No exhibitor may withdraw horses from the show after it has commenced, or remove them from the grounds, without the permission of the show manager.

GENERAL INFORMATION

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES - All entries are accepted with the understanding that the AHA of Northern California Region 3 AHA and Murieta Equine Complex not be held responsible for any loss damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss damage or injury to any person animal or property occasioned by him his agents or employees or by an animal owned or exhibited any and shall indemnify the AHA of Northern California Region 3 AHA and Murieta Equine Complex against any and all loss damages and liability thus occasioned including but not limited to any and all legal costs including attorney fees which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

JUDGES - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize List. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

LOCATION OF CLASSES - Show management reserves the right to hold classes or portions of classes on the grounds outside the Main Arena if it is found necessary to do so or to change and/or modify the Schedule of Events as necessary to accommodate the entries received.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES - Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

PERFORMANCE HALTER INFORMATION AR123 General

2. Open, Amateur and Junior Exhibitor classes may be held. Classes will not be split by horse's age. Exception: "Prospect" class for horses two and under at the discretion of show management. Classes must be separated by Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian. In addition, they must be separated by stallion, mare and gelding. All horses three years of age and older must have been entered and shown in a performance class (Under Saddle and/or Driving) at the same show as the one in which the performance halter class is being held, or have completed an AHA sanctioned Endurance ride or a Competitive Trail Ride recognized by AHA or sanctioned by an AHA recognized Competitive Trail riding organization in the past 90 days. If a horse is disqualified, excused, or voluntarily withdrawn from a performance class, that class may not be used to qualify for Performance Halter. Horses qualifying via Endurance or Competitive Trail must present dated proof of completion to the show secretary. If classes are held in conjunction with an AHA sanctioned Endurance ride or a Competitive Trail riding organization, all registered Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horses entered in the ride are eligible to compete.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Horses entered in regional championship classes must be qualified in a show that was held within the preceding calendar year and that period of the current year up to the commencement of the Pacific Slope Championship show. See AHA Handbook for qualification requirements.

REFUNDS

Horses may be scratched from the show at the owner's option. No refunds after entry closing date (March 17). Substitution of horses will be permitted as stated in USEF GR911.

RESOLUTION 9-90 FEE - Every horse competing in these shows must pay \$10.00 PER HORSE ONLY ONCE to fund the Education & Evaluation program for A.H.A. judges & stewards.

SHARPS CONTAINERS - Competition management must place a minimum of one (1) sharps container per competition, regardless of whether stabling is provided.

a. If stabling is provided, for every fifty (50) occupied stalls, one (1) sharps container must be provided for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. These containers must be placed in visible, accessible, and convenient locations in barns housing competition horses.

b. Sharps Containers: A sharps container is made of puncture-resistant plastic with leak-resistant sides and bottom. It has a tight fitting, puncture resistant lid, which does not allow sharps to come out of the container. Sharps containers must be properly labeled to warn of hazardous waste inside the container. Sharps containers must not be altered in any way from its manufactured form, such as removal of security measures or drilling of the plastic. Sharps containers must be protected from the elements as to not collect rainwater

c. It is competition management's responsibility to dispose of contents of sharps containers when the container is three-quarters (3/4) full, in accordance with community guidelines for proper disposal methods. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

d. If local law has more stringent requirements than the above, related to sharps containers or disposal, local law will prevail. Competitions that fail to place the required number of containers on the competition grounds or dispose of the contents properly will be considered in violation of the rules

USEF / DRUG FEE - For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation (USEF) a \$16.00 Federation Fee will be collected per horse (\$8 shall be an Equine Drugs and Medication fee to provide for research inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1.2 and .3) An exhibitor must file an official Equine Drugs and Medications Report Form (in writing) with the Show Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative within one hour after administration or one hour after the Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative returns to duty if administration is at a time other than during competition hours. The official Drugs and Medication Report Form is available from the officiating Show Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative.

VETERINARIAN - A veterinarian will be on call throughout the show. All animals are subject to physical inspection by the Show Veterinarian at the discretion of the Show Committee. The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to or which may be harboring a communicable disease. No veterinarian other than the official show veterinarian will be permitted to treat medicate or attend to a horse on the grounds. Anyone wishing to use another veterinarian other than the official Show Veterinarian on the grounds must obtain permission from Show Manager.

WESTERN DRESSAGE CLASSES BREAKING TIES

1. In the event two or more competitors have equal points (a tie), the tie shall be broken pursuant to WD126.6 in the USEF Rule Book except when after a review of the scores for Collective Marks/General Impressions there remains a tie, the tie must be broken as follows:

a. The competitor with the highest Collective Mark scores by the judge sitting at C shall be declared the winner of the tie; and

b. In the event there remains a tie with the judge's (sitting at C) Collective Mark scores, the winner of the tie shall be determined by that judge's scores as follows:

1. The competitor with the highest free walk score or the highest extended walk score shall be determined the winner; and 2. In the event there is a tie on the free walk/extended walk score, the competitor with the highest

sum of scores with coefficients greater than one shall be determined the winner; and

3. In the event there is a tie based on the sum or the scores with coefficients greater than one, the competitor with the first highest Collective Mark score shall be determined the winner. (Start at the top of the collective mark scores and work down until the tie is broken); and

4. In the event that the Collective Mark scores are identical, the competitor with the first highest movement score shall be determined the winner. (Start at the top of the movement scores and work down until the tie is broken). If a tie still remains, the judge(s) must break the tie.

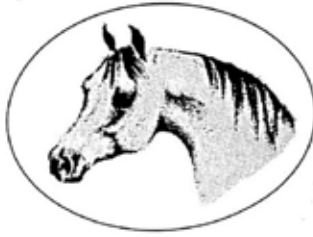

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR RULES FOR DRESSAGE - From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted.

The Pacific Slope Championship classes qualify for US and Canadian National competitions just as a Regional competition does.

Points/Placings from most shows in Regions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 7 will qualify for the Pacific Slope Championship Classes;

Just check with the sponsoring club to see if they have joined Pacific Slope.

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States with a membership of nearly 30,000 members, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

USDF Membership Benefits: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.
